

Confucius was born in the small state of <u>Lu</u>







He was born into an aristocratic family. His father died when he was 3.

His mother <u>educated him at home</u>. Confucius, received training in the traditional six subjects to be studied: "rites, music, archery, chariot driving, <u>writing and mathematics</u>.

As a teenager, Confucius worked as <u>a book keeper</u>, shepherd and minor posts in the <u>government</u>.

He loved <u>learning</u>

He married at the age of 19

In his thirties, Confucius started <u>teaching</u> He became known as the first teacher in China who wanted to provide <u>education for all</u>

Confucius lived in a time of political <u>violence</u>. This period was known as the <u>Warring States period</u>. Many of his teachings and sayings emphasized proper conduct and behavior which would result in political stability. He felt that education was essential in the development of just leaders.

Confucius's teachings had great influence in Chinese society. He placed a lot of emphasis on relationships and one's role in society. He advocated an honest and fair government.

His philosophies influenced the Chinese educational, governmental and family systems. He emphasized five relationships in society: (1) ruler and subject; (2) father and son; (3) husband and wife; (4) elder brother and younger brother; and (5) friend and friend.

One of Confucius's major teachings was <u>felial</u> piety, which means devotion to one's <u>parents</u> He emphasized proper social <u>behavior and etiquette</u>.
