## Homemade Chocolate Chip Cookies

Mix  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup butter with  $\frac{3}{4}$  cup brown sugar and  $\frac{3}{4}$  cup white sugar

Add 2 eggs

Mix in 1 teaspoon salt, 1 teaspoon baking powder and 1 teaspoon vanilla extract

Add  $2\frac{1}{4}$  cup flour

Mix well.

Add in 1 cup of semi-sweet chocolate chips.

Drop batter onto a well-greased cookie tray.

Bake in a pre-heated oven at 350° for 9 mins 30 seconds (or until slightly brown around the edges).

Salt often comes from salt mines.



butter

White and brown refined sugar comes from sugar cane. Commercial brown sugar is white sugar with molasses added to it.



flour

Flour comes from wheat



eggs

In the cacao pod (right) are seeds. Seeds are the main ingredient in chocolate.



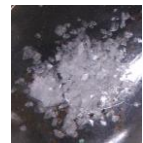
baking powder

Butter is a solid dairy product made from cream or milk.



salt

Baking powder is bicarbonate, cornstarch and monocalcium phosphate.



vanilla

Vanilla extract comes from vanilla beans.



chocolate chips

Eggs come from chickens.
